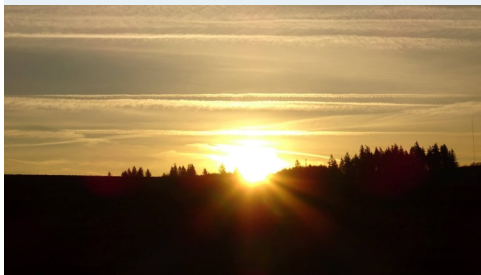


## Valley View Cemetery

## Our Story

Valley View Lutheran Cemetery was created in 1897 by both Immanuel Lutheran Church and Trinity Lutheran Churches in Silverton, Oregon, for the members of the congregations and their families to have a place to be laid to rest. The land for the cemetery was donated by the Loe family, who farm the surrounding fields to this day. Valley View has a rich history of people from the Silverton area, and people come back home to be laid to rest here from all over the United States.

The Cemetery is managed and maintained by a board of 6 people, three from each congregation. Valley View is open to all, and we have added a Columbarium to our beautiful landscape to provide people with more options.

## Do's and Don't's

### DO:

- Bring fresh flowers and use an available vase to place them by your family members grave space.
- Come and pay your respects between the hours of 9:00AM to 6:00 PM.
- Let the board know if you need any assistance in caring for your plot
- Keep your pets leashed and pick up after them please.

### DON'T:

- Place plastic flowers at your family members grave space
- Use glass vases for flowers
- Place mementos or statues on or near your family members headstone
- Let your pets run off leash

These rules are for the protection of your belongings and for the safety of our caretakers. Anything other than fresh flowers will be removed and discarded. We are not responsible for damage or theft to personal belongings left at the cemetery.

## Pricing

Our pricing is updated occasionally to reflect the cost of care to maintain our beautiful cemetery and staying in line with the other cemeteries in our area.

Plot	\$1,500
Niche (Columbarium)	\$1,000
Cremaains added to a plot	\$600

A \$25 recording fee is added for each burial\*

### Cremaains—Open/Close Fees

Monday—Friday \$350

Saturday \$500

There are no Burials on Sundays or Holidays

\* If you have a reserved plot/niche, there is still a recording fee of \$25.
